## An invitation to the **Eastside Recycling Facility,** **Hereford Quarries & Warehouse 701**

The investment into the Wye Valley Group's Eastside Recycling Facility has continued since its development commenced in 2000. The original 28 acre brownfield site was purchased requiring remediation and bespoke construction following detailed design that took into consideration its proximity to the SSSI River Wye. The site finally opening as a dedicated recycling facility in 2006.

It is now the Wye Valley Group's centre of operations, the complex now totalling 35 acres, with over 100 local employees, processing over 200,000 tonnes of wastes annually; hazardous, non-hazardous and inert, running at a recycling rate in excess of 99.9%; with less than 0.1% of wastes going to landfill.

Investments in infrastructure have included; £1.5M 1000T processing shear, a haulage fleet specified to the latest 2017 emissions standards and an in-land dock facility allowing global export direct from site. It is also one of the first dedicated recycling facilities in the UK to attain ISO: 9001, ISO:14001 and BS OHSAS:18001 International standards for all their activities. This includes waste management, hazardous waste handling, DVLA End-of-Life Vehicle destruction, skip hire, WEEE, scrap metal, waste carrying and all the associated recycling operations.

The facility is also one of the first recycling sites in the UK to gain an EA approved Fire Prevention Plan in response to the high profile national waste fire prevention programme.

The facility operates both locally and nationally; based on the edge of the Hereford Enterprise Zone, Skylon Park, and has been heavily involved in its development. The company also works with the major utilities and transport operators such as Network Rail and National Grid coordinating UK wide contracts from its Hereford Head Office. One of our businesses, Wye Valley Metals, also recently featured in the LSE top 1000 businesses who inspire Britain.



Starting with a redundant 10 acre quarry site in 2014, a planning application to the local authority to import inert waste to the site was successfully gained. The site was shortly thereafter licensed as an Environment Agency 'Permitted' facility in 2015.

The site has now installed a state-of-the-art £2 million Secondary Aggregate washing plant. This enables the facility to recover a significantly higher percentage and quality of aggregate to include sharp sand, coarse sand, 10mm, 20mm, 40mm & 80mm products.

With the potential of processing up to 240,000 tonnes of waste annually working to WRAP protocols, the facility can produce a range of fully compliant saleable products and importantly divert construction waste from landfill.

It also reduces the need for the county to import virgin aggregates from quarries, subsequently improving CO2 emissions and traffic levels within the county.

The site now has 10 employees and is experiencing fantastic growth in output.


